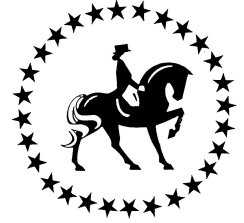

The Championships are open to horse and rider combinations who have earned qualifying scores at two or more Cornerstone Shows between December, 2005 and July 31, 2006. Scores for Training Level through Fourth Level must be a minimum of 60%. Scores for FEI must be a minimum of 58%. Horse & rider combinations must compete in the Championship class at the same level in which they qualified. Horses may be ridden in only one Championship Class, even if qualified in more than one level. Tests must be ridden from memory and whips will not be allowed.

The Championships are open to horse and rider combinations who have earned qualifying scores at two or more Cornerstone Shows between December, 2005 and July 31, 2006. Scores for Training Level through Fourth Level must be a minimum of 62%. Scores for FEI must be a minimum of 60%. Horse & rider combinations must compete in the Championship class at the same level in which they qualified. Horses may be ridden in only one Championship Class, even if qualified in more than one level. Tests must be ridden from memory and whips will not be allowed.

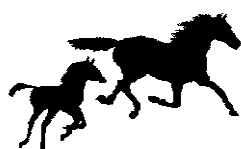
516. **Amateur/Junior/Young Rider Handler** - To be shown in hand on the triangle by an Amateur, Junior or Young Rider. Handlers must be at least 14 years of age. To be judged on presentation of the horse to the judge, neatness & appearance of the handler, & overall condition of the horse. Conformation will not be a determining factor & may not count more than 15%.

Dressage Suitability (Fees \$35.00 Per Class)

To be shown on light contact at the walk, trot, & canter both ways of the ring. To be judged on quality of gaits, balance, presence & manners. Older horses may be asked to lengthen the stride at the trot (no more than 6 horses will be asked at one time).

517. **Dressage Suitability** - open to horses three & four years old not competing above Training level.

518. **Dressage Suitability** - open to horses five & six years old not competing above First level.

Non-Championship Group Classes (FEES \$50.00 PER GROUP PER CLASS)

Classes below to be shown in hand. To move at the judge's discretion. To be judged on overall quality of movement, conformation and general impression of entry. Entry fee per group not per horse. Entries in produce of dam and get of sire must be made by the owner of the dam or sire, or with the written permission from the owner, in the name of that dam or sire. To be scored 50% movement, 40% conformation, 10% general impression.

534. **Produce of Dam** (Dam not to be judged) - two or three produce of the same dam entered under dam's name. Multiple ownership permitted. Limited to two groups. All produce to be listed by name on mare's entry form along with the owners.

535. **Get of Sire** (Sire not present) - two or three get of the same sire entered under sire's name. Multiple ownership permitted. Limited to two groups. All get to be listed by name on stallion's entry form along with the owners.

Materiale Classes (\$35.00 per class)

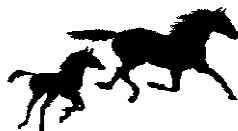
Horses will be evaluated according to the criteria listed on the "USDF Dressage Sport Horse Prospects Under Saddle" Score sheets. Horses will first be evaluated under saddle at the walk, trot and canter in both directions of the arena. No more than six horses will be asked to canter at one time. Four and five year old horses may be asked to lengthen the stride at the trot and canter. After all horses have completed the under saddle portion of the class, riders will be asked to line up and dismount to prepare for in-hand conformation judging. As horses are lining up, one or two handlers or assistant handlers may enter ring and assist. A maximum of four minutes will be allowed from the time the handler an/or assistant handlers enter the arena to the start of the in-hand judging. The judge determines the order and method in which the horses are presented for in-hand evaluation. Horses are not shown on the triangle; movement is judged only while the horse is under saddle. Horses may be presented by the rider, handler or assistant handler. Handlers and assistant handlers may prepare and present one or more horses for in-hand judging as long as it does not delay the completion of the class. Horses must be a least 36 months of age to participate in Materiale Classes

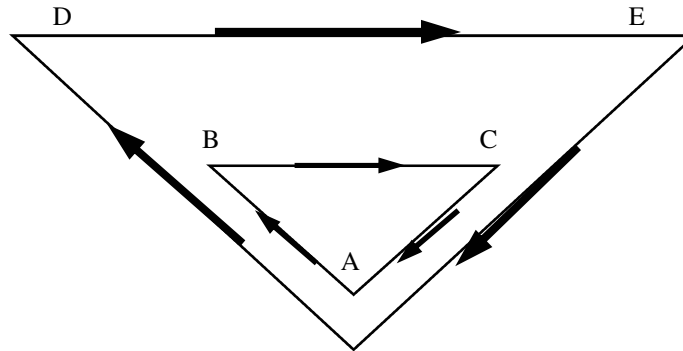
In order to ensure the safety of exhibitors and horses the classes will be run in the following order:

SATURDAY: CLASSES WILL BE RUN IN NUMERICAL ORDER

SUNDAY: 518 - 520 - 522 - 524 - 526 - 528 - 529 - 532 - 519 - 521 - 523 - 525 - 527 - 530 - 531 - 533 - 534 - 535 - 536 - 537 - 538 - 539

CLASS PROCEDURE

All competitors are responsible for reading and understanding the USEF Dressage/Sport Horse Breeding rules in the 2006 USEF Dressage Division Rule Book. Any horse entering the arena, whether being judged or not, must be controlled by a handler or handler's assistant. **NO HORSE, INCLUDING FOALS, MAY BE SHOWN LOOSE.** Championship Class Procedure - Horses will be shown at the walk as a group and individually at the trot. In classes with 20 or more entries the horses with the top scores may be recalled as a group for re-evaluation. The triangle measures approximately 30 meters on the long side and 22 meters on each of the short sides. When called by the Ringmaster, present your horse to the Judge at "A" for conformation judging. Upon direction, follow the procedure as diagrammed below:



1. Stand horse at "A" for conformation judging
2. Walk small triangle - A - B - C - A
3. Trot large Triangle - A - D - E - A
4. Leave judging area promptly unless requested to do otherwise by judge.

BREED DIVISION RULES

1. **Braiding:** Braiding is optional for all entries
2. **Equipment & Turnout:** In accordance with USEF Dressage Sport Horse Breeding Rules
3. **Handlers:** Handlers may have one assistant, if necessary. Prior to entering the ring, all handlers and assistants must have, on file in the show secretary's office, a Handler/Assistant release form. **ANYONE HOLDING A HORSE WHILE IT IS BEING JUDGED, INCLUDING CALL-BACKS FOR PINNING, IS CONSIDERED A HANDLER AND MUST BE A USEF MEMBER OR PAY THE NON-MEMBER FEE.**
4. **Behavior:** A judge may excuse from the ring any unruly horse or one whose actions threaten to endanger other exhibitors or their entries
